### Biography of John Kornitzer

John C. Kornitzer is Founder and CEO of Kornitzer Capital Management and the Buffalo Funds, a no-load mutual fund group, and founder of Great Plains Trust Company. In addition to these roles, he is a portfolio manager. His firm Kornitzer Capital Management (KCM) manages over \$6 billion in investments for clients around the world, including high net worth individuals, foundations, corporations, trusts mutual funds and retirement plans. Prior to founding KCM, Mr. Kornitzer was Vice President of Investments for Employers Reinsurance Corp. He joined ERC in 1978, and managed assets for the company through acquisitions by Getty Oil, Texaco and finally General Electric, where he ran the investment portfolios for ERC until founding KCM in 1989. Kornitzer's extensive experience also includes 11 years on Wall Street; seven years for Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith Inc. and four years as Vice President and managing partner of Butcher & Singer's New York region. Mr. Kornitzer is a former Principal of the New York Stock Exchange, a founding governor of the National Organization of Investment Professionals and past Chairman and President of the Kansas City Securities Association.



Mr. Kornitzer has lectured and taught around the world and has been interviewed and quoted by The Wall Street Journal, New York Times, Barron's, USA Today, Investors Business Daily, Louis Rukeyser's Mutual Funds, Forbes, Fortune, Smart Money, Kiplingers, Business Week, Bloomberg News and many other financial news publications. He has also had frequent guest appearances on TV and radio interviews.

Mr. Kornitzer sits on many philanthropic boards and supports numerous civic and charitable causes, but he has a special, passionate belief in the NAIA's Champions of Character program of core values (Respect, Responsibility, Integrity, Servant Leadership and Sportsmanship) and bringing the program to youth.
